Uniting the Mon Valley to ensure the long-term health, safety, and well-being of individuals in the region.

### Provider Resources

Like diabetes or hypertension, addiction is a chronic disease, meaning it cannot be cured by medication, but can be managed. Individuals can improve their health by managing their symptoms in a structured-treatment center. The goal is to help them maintain their health in a home-like environment.

Research tells us that ongoing involvement in recovery-related activities is the best predictor of long-term sobriety. Active engagement with recovery support is especially important during the first 18 months of recovery when the risk of relapse is the most intense.

### There are choices for medication

**Methadone** and **Buprenorphine** (Suboxone®) trick the brain into thinking it is still getting the problem opioid. The person taking the medication feels 'normal', not high, and withdrawal does not occur. These medications also help to reduce cravings.

**Vivitrol/Naltrexone** helps a person overcome addiction in a different way. It blocks the effect of opioid drugs. This takes away the feeling of getting high if the problem drug is used again. This feature makes Naltrexone a good choice to prevent relapse.

Licensed treatment providers evaluate individuals and help them to determine the pathway to recovery that works best for them.
